Scope of Work: Proposal provides for the re-landscaping of portions of Harmony Town Square after a walk through with Field Operations Manager Gerhard van der Snel. Much of the existing plant material consists of older Ilex that have over time declined. Since the original installation, the surrounding trees have matured changing the light that reaches some of the beds being proposed. The materials selected take all of the new conditions into consideration.

All work includes preparation, installation, debris removal / disposal, and clean-up of debris generated during course of work inclusive of pressure washing sidewalks upon job completion.

Proposing to installed Society Garlic to each side of entry walk way.



Proposing to remove Azaleas and install a half moon of Ginger to fill out behind the sitting bench.



Proposing to remove declining Ilex and Azaleas, and install Ginger in a half moon shape to fill out behind the bench. Bed needs to be reduced with sod.



Proposing to remove Ilex and install Coontie palms on the corner. The African Iris will be divided and spread out using additional Iris to fill the area making it an Iris bed.



Proposing to remove the declining Iris on the corner and install Coontie Palms to match the other side of the side walk.



The existing African Iris in this photo will be divided and spaced out using additional proposed Iris, which will fill out and create a complete Iris bed. They are beautiful and blood white flowers.

Proposing to remove declining Iris and fill with Coontie Palms which are thriving in the shade to the left.



Proposing to fill this wide open bed with Firecracker which is thriving on the stage side of the square.



Proposing to remove declining ilex behind the sitting bench and install ginger in a half moon shape to fill out area behind the bench.



This bed is seen when you stop at the stop sign and are facing the square. To tie the look together, proposing to install juniper and gold mounds similar to what was installed at the East Entrance.



Proposing to remove Azaleas featured in this photo, and install Jack Frost Ligustrum.
