The “**Titles**” for these “**Positions**” are either the names of the “Jobs” that are performed (*e.g.*, District Manager, District Engineer, District Counsel), or they are simply generic salutations like Mr. or Ms. – nothing else!

Generic Salutory Titles (options) in Records of the HCDD Board:

- **Mr.** – male member/participant (marital status undefined)
- **Ms.** – female member/participant (marital status unstated)
- **Mrs.** – female member/participant (married else unknown)
- **Miss** – female member/participant (unmarried or unstated)

Traditionally, and by precedence, these are the salutory titles that are employed in the Minutes of HCDD Board Meetings, even though during the conduct of a meeting members are referred to as Supervisor XYZ, Chairman YZX, or Vice Chairman ZXY. To do otherwise is to artificially “elevate” the stature of one member over another based on “credentials” that have nothing whatsoever to do with “qualifications” to be a member, nor their “worth”, or “value”, or “contribution” while serving as a member.
